## Notice of Clarification: Domestic Relations Custody Orders for School and Holiday Visitation

Questions have arisen with respect to the interpretation of child parenting time/visitation schedules during the school closings necessitated by the Coronavirus/ COVID-19. In an effort to help the Family Law Bar to advise your clients, the Fulton Superior Court Family Division Judges have met and unanimously agreed that in all cases in which child parenting time/visitation is governed by a school calendar, parenting time/visitation will continue to be governed by the previously published school calendar regardless of any break or homeschooling necessitated by the current public health crisis. Spring Break, holiday and summer parenting time/visitations will continue to be governed by the controlling school calendar in the manner stated in the applicable custody order in each case.
