Coosa Valley Credit Union offers full financial services for both consumers and businesses. Lobby hours are from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday and from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Fridays. The drive-thru is open from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Fridays.

More details will be shared regarding a ribbon cutting ceremony and grand opening for the new location once they are finalized.
