Nominations also may be submitted by petitions by member. Members who desire to name a nominee or nominees for vacancy should prepare and submit a petition in accordance with the following procedures:

- (A) Petition must be signed by at least 1% of members with a minimum of 20 and a maximum of 500 of the membership of Coosa Valley Federal Credit Union (Membership with the Credit Union should be as of 09/01/2015) and must include their account number.
- (B) Petition must be accompanied by a certification from the nominee or nominees stating that they are agreeable to nomination and will serve if elected to office. Each nominee by petition must submit a statement of qualifications and biographical data with their petition. The nominee or nominees must state that they will be able to attend Board Meetings and devote such time as needed to fulfill this obligation.
- (C) Petition must be filed with the Secretary of the Credit Union by January 1st, 2016. These may be left at the Credit Union Office and will be forwarded to the Board Secretary.
- (D) Only members eighteen (18) years of age or older will be eligible to vote.

#### Coosa Valley Credit Union Honored with First-Place State Dora Maxwell Award

Coosa Valley Credit Union has won the 2015 Dora Maxwell Social Responsibility Community Service Award in its asset size

for the state of Georgia with its creation of "The American Flag Project". Dora Maxwell was an early credit union pioneer, and was one of the original signers of CUNA's constitutions at Estes Park in Colorado. She worked as an organizer for the movement's trade association and held numerous volunteer positions at the local and national level. In addition to organizing hundreds of credit unions, she developed volunteer organizer clubs and worked with organizations on behalf of the poor. "We are very excited and honored to receive this award. It represents the commitment by Coosa Valley Credit Union's entire staff to make a difference in the communities we serve." stated Robert E. Smyth AVP of Marketing and Business Development for Coosa Valley. The entry will now progress to the Credit Union National Association's national award competition, with the winners honored at the 2015 CUNA Government Affairs Conference in Washington, D.C.

#### 9/11 Ceremony

Coosa Valley Credit Unions AVP of Marketing Robert Smyth and members of the community in Rome met Friday morning September 11th at Memorial Plaza in front of the Joint Law Enforcement Center in downtown Rome to honor the lives lost in the attack in 2001. The event included the ringing of local church bells, the Last Alarm to honor the lives of the firemen and other first responders who died that day, and an impromptu singing of "God Bless America," led by Rome native Harry Wise of the Rome Exchange Club.
