The Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) serves individuals with long-term care needs by providing access to the entire continuum of health care services. The PACE program's mission is to keep seniors living independently and safely for as long as possible.

Our Philosophy

The PACE model is centered around the belief that it is better for the well-being of seniors with long-term care needs and their families to be served in the community whenever possible.

PACE is Unique

- All-inclusive care plan: 24/7; 365
- Integrates preventive, primary, acute, rehab & Long-Term Care services
- All Medicare and Medicaid services PLUS No benefit limitation/co-pay/deductible for dually eligible
- Services delivered in most appropriate setting

Who's Eligible?

- Age 55 or older
- Live in the Reid Health PACE service area
- Meet nursing facility level of care
- Able to live safely in the community with assistance from Reid Health PACE

PACE Services

Including but not limited to:

- Nursing
- PT/OT/RT
- Social Services
- Meals and Nutritional Counseling
- Medical Care with PACE Primary Care Provider
- Dentist, Audiologist, Optometrist, Podiatrist
- In home care
- Medications & durable medical equipment
- Transportation

*Services are provided in the most appropriate setting

What does PACE cost?

- What you pay for PACE depends on your eligibility under Medicare and Medicaid.
- If you are eligible for Medicaid, or dually eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid, you won't pay a monthly premium for PACE.
- If you don't qualify for Medicaid, but you have Medicare, you'll be charged a monthly premium for PACE.
- There's no deductible or copayment for any drug, service, or care approved by your health care team.
- If you don't have Medicare or Medicaid, you can pay for PACE privately.
