What does an annual preventative wellness exam consist of?

Annual preventative wellness exams are intended to discuss existing health maintenance for existing, stable known problems and preventative measures as designated by your physician. This may include but is not limited to screenings for conditions such as: diabetes, high cholesterol, hypertension, heart or kidney disease, and some cancers. The visit may also include updating vaccinations as well as screening tests, such as a colonoscopy or mammogram being scheduled, and/or additional lab tests being ordered.

This visit is typically covered by most commercial insurance plans. However, presenting with a **new** problem or significant escalation of an existing problem **may** lead to an additional office visit and/or lab test charge being entered due to the additional time needed by your physician to explore health history and provide further examination.

If your visit today is scheduled as a preventative annual wellness exam and any new or significantly worsening problems are addressed, **additional fees may be charged for the date of service**. Please feel free to ask your doctor or member of our office team if you have any questions or concerns prior to your appointment.

Any additional lab work and/or testing may lead to an increase in charges for the date of service.



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
