EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

At Telhio Credit Union, we've been putting

PEOPLE OVER PROFIT.

Telhio Credit Union is where banking and community come together. But what is community? It can be defined in so many ways; sometimes it is a location, a common interest, sometimes it is online, sometimes it is in person – but always, it is the coming together of people.

This year, we brought together our values of integrity, commitment and caring to create physical spaces and innovative products and partnerships that foster a sense of community. In collaboration with Crimson Cup Coffee & Tea, we opened our Beckett Ridge branch where members could bank, meet, and work over a cup of coffee. We were awarded the Larry Schumacher Beautification Award from the West Chester-Liberty Chamber Alliance for this new brick-and-mortar location.

Our Park Avenue branch in Hamilton, Ohio celebrated community through art. A new mural, "Cultivating Community," was painted on the outside of the building and accomplished through the StreetSpark Program, a public art initiative in partnership with The Fitton Center for the Creative Arts. Design elements and symbolism embedded in "Cultivating Community" are intended to synthesize with the architectural structure of the Telhio Credit Union branch and provide contemporary and historical nods to the surrounding environment, while communicating a whimsical uplifting image that communicates tranquility, peace, and prosperity.

As an organization, Telhio believes in building a spirit of community and being an active presence in the communities we serve. We proudly supported organizations like Autism Speaks, Mid-Ohio Food Collective, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Butler County, and Hockey and Hounds. We continued our commitment to education by awarding our Telhio Scholarship to help three student members achieve their goals. Through our community efforts, we also donated over \$24,000 to Ronald McDonald House Charities.

As we moved through 2021, we expanded Telhio's footprint by merging with Columbus Metro, bringing our membership to 75,000 and more than \$1.2 billion in assets. We also completed a \$1.5 million expansion at our Northland Village location. The branch now boasts a state-of-the-art building with robust banking technology. We also broke ground on a new branch on Polaris Parkway in Westerville, Ohio, set to open in Spring 2022. Beyond our brick-and-mortar developments, Telhio Credit Union also enhanced its online presence by launching a new and improved website and online banking platform.

This year's nominating committee recommended eight candidates to fill the open positions for the 2022 Board of Directors. This year's election was uncontested so the following individuals were elected by affirmation: David Burns, Fred Harris, Larry Jackson, Doug McDowell, Chinita Montgomery, George Mussi, Mark Wilkerson, Pat Zollars. For this year's election, there were 67,733 eligible voting members; 932 proxy votes were cast by Telhio's membership and certified by E Space Communications.



TREASURER'S

REPORT

The 2021 fiscal year was highlighted with expansion and growth as Telhio and the former Columbus Metro Federal Credit Union completed a merger in February 2022. As a result of the merger and normal course of business, loans (21%), deposits (35%), equity (34%) and assets (34%) all saw significant growth over fiscal year 2021. Telhio ended the fiscal year with assets of \$1.26 billion and total equity of \$124 million.

A strong return on average assets ratio of 1.15% allowed Telhio to remain a well-capitalized, safe and sound financial institution with a net worth ratio of 9.80%. As always Telhio remains focused on providing essential financial products and services to our members.

I would like to remind you that your credit union is regulated and monitored by state and federal agencies, in addition to the formal audit by our outside auditing firm, Lillie and Company, LLC. The State of Ohio's Division of Financial Institutions and the National Credit Union Administration are active partners of your federally insured credit union. Simply put, your credit union remains in regulatory compliance and maintains its high standards of financial stability and service to you, our member.




In furthering our commitment to putting people over profit, Telhio works to provide our members and community with free, accessible financial education.

BECKETT RIDGE BRANCH OPENING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH CRIMSON CUP COFFEE & TEA

On November 29, we opened our Beckett Ridge branch in Huzleman Square located in West Chester, Ohio. The 6,281 square foot banking center includes a Crimson Cup Coffee & Tea with a drive thru window and patio seating, a first of its kind partnership for Telhio Credit Union. The destination includes a large conference room and community room for members and community personnel to enjoy.

"CULTIVATING COMMUNITY" AT PARK AVENUE BRANCH

Telhio Credit Union's Park Avenue branch cultivated community through Art. The mural "Cultivating Community" was painted on the exterior of the building and completed through the StreetSpark Program, a public art initiative in partnership with The Fitton Center for the Creative Arts.

The concept for "Cultivating Community", designed by local artist Jamie Schorsch, was inspired by Telhio's core values of caring, commitment and integrity. Design elements and symbolism embedded in "Cultivating Community" are intended to synthesize with the architectural structure of the Telhio branch, provide contemporary and historical nods to the surrounding environment as well as the function on Telhio nurturing the community, while communicating a whimsical uplifting image that communicates tranquility, peace, and prosperity.

NORTHLAND VILLAGE EXPANSION PROJECT

In 2020, we began the process of completing a \$1.5 million expansion of our Northland Village building, with a ribbon cutting on January 5, 2021. This branch features an Interactive Banking Kiosks (IBK) with biometric authentication, also known as palm vein scan. This specific technology is the most robust biometric feature to date and very secure. ITM's can dispense coins, vary the denomination of dollars withdrawn as cash, print out statements, and even allow members to make payments on loans or mortgages through the machine.
