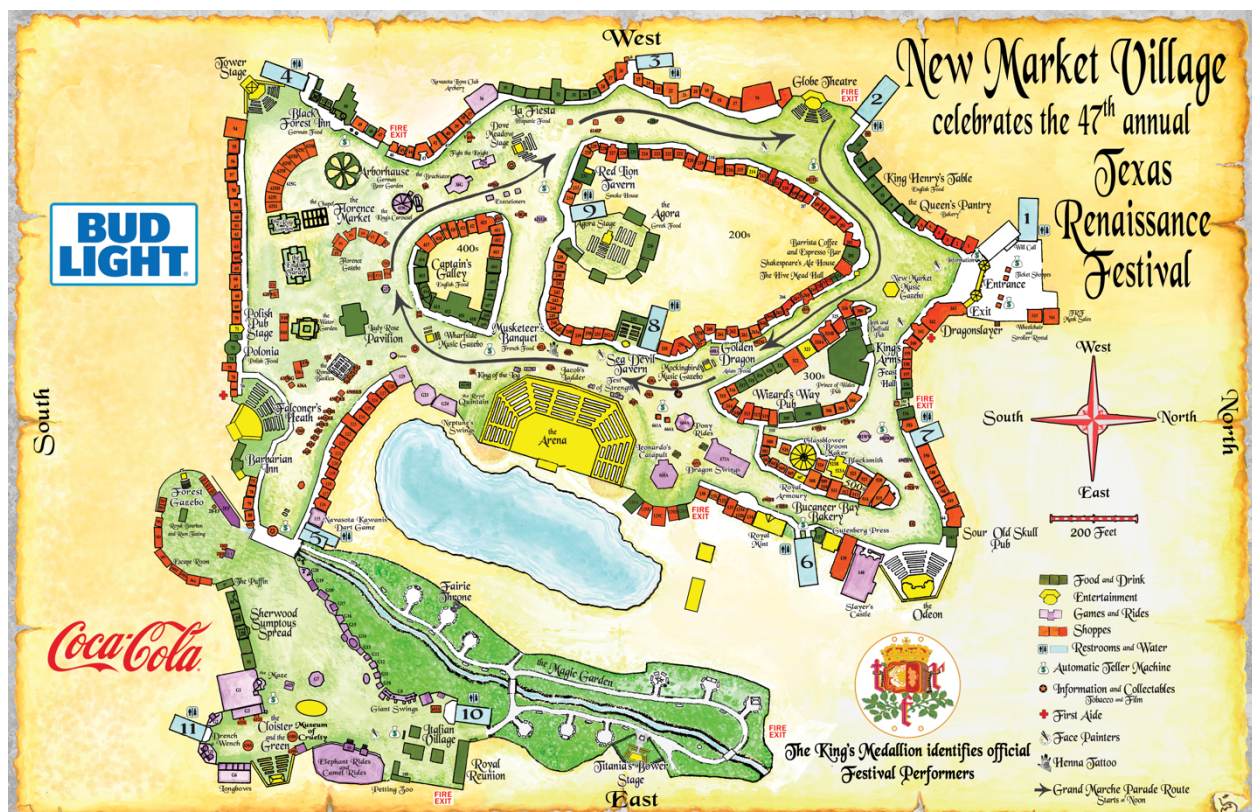




ABOUT TEXAS RENAISSANCE FESTIVAL: 47 YEARS OF ENCHANTING ENTERTAINMENT

The Texas Renaissance Festival is the nation's largest Renaissance event. Each year, over 450,000 patrons enter through the gates of the festival into a 16th Century European Village where performers immerse you in the enchantment of the village that feature 21 stages of music and stage acts, 400 shoppes, artisans, and a world tour for the taste buds that of course includes turkey legs! - **NEW! [Wine Tasting at Odin's Table by Haak Vineyards and Winery](#):** This unique Texas Wine Tasting, one fit for the gods, is created by knowledgeable staff. Guests 21 and older will taste five very distinct Haak wines:
 - Mead-style white wine, White Port, Tawny Port, Blanc du Bois Madeira and "Renaissance" Jacquez Madeira



- [The King's Feast](#) offers something for everyone's taste from lands across the world. For a more formal, exclusive renaissance-era dining experience, guests can indulge in every bite, each day at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- [Pub Crawl](#), or for better words, pub crusade is for festivalgoers 21 and older! A two-hour tour through the seedy underbelly of what passes for wit in the alehouses of the Renaissance, the Holy Heralds of Hops will ply you with dirty jokes, lewd songs, drinking games, general debauchery, and of course beer – five to be exact – all the better to lubricate your tongues. A commemorative tasting glass is also yours to keep, and at the end of the crusade, the participant who provides the most inappropriate source of laughter for the rest of us will receive a special prize of (dis)honor to mark their contribution to the Holy Heralds of Hops' epic Quest of the Holy Fail.
- **NEW!** [Royal Scotch or Royal Bourbon & Rum Tastings](#), for guests 21 and older, is an experience fit for a king. Tastings on the hour begin at 10 a.m. each day. Patrons may also purchase a glass of scotch any way they like it and enjoy it in the shop.
- **NEW!** [Escape Rooms](#) are full of adventures, for ages 14 and older, and held in a giant, newly renovated air-conditioned location! The room themes include Airy Botter & The Sorcery School Headmaster's Office, Airy Botter & The Alchemist's Lab, The Pirates' Dilemma, and The King's Guard. The King's Guard and Pirate's Dilemma rooms can be played by two groups in a competition!
- **NEW!** Del Lago is a new, expanded section of the kingdom located near the Jousting Arena. The festival has moved the horse stables back near the lake and are rebuilding several new shoppes and royal wine tasting for festivalgoers to indulge as they please.

FAMILY FRIENDLY FUN FOR ALL AGES

- **Food & Drink** | All vendors will have a selection of King's Sodas, bottled water, bottled iced tea, fruit drinks, and bottled lemonade. Most vendors will also have a selection of King's Brews (domestic, import, and premium), Messina Hof wines, mead, ciders, and frozen adult beverages. On cool days, you'll find hot chocolate, coffee, cider, and mulled wine.
- **Shoppes** | If you can think of it, you can find it in the shoppes of Texas Renaissance Festival. From adornment, candles and clothiers to lotions, potions, musical instruments and woodwork (and everything in between!), you can find it here!
- **Rides, Games & Activities** | There are hand powered rides, fun games of skill, exciting attractions, and fun children's activities located throughout New Market Village. Most rides and activities cost between \$3 to \$5 per person, though prices vary, so ask your attendant. Festivalgoers can spin in giant dragon eggs, test your strength in The Joust Tower, wander through the Museum of Cruelty or ride atop an elephant or camel. Whatever thou heart desires, thou can find it in New Market Village!

COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

Texas Renaissance Festival will comply with any mandates or safety protocols issued by the State of Texas. The festival's first responsibility as a business is the safety of employees, customers, and the community. To allow this to happen safely, all festival participants (TRF Employees, Contracted Vendors, Employees of Vendors and Performers) will be required to supply proof of vaccination against COVID-19 or are required to be tested weekly ahead of festival celebrations. Proof of vaccination or an approved exemption form in combination with weekly negative tests will be required. Masks and vaccines are not required for ticketed visitors or season pass holders at this time.
